## QUALIFICATIONS FOR TSU-CAT:

You are qualified to take the TSU-CAT, if;

1. You completed/ are completing senior high school.
2. You are high school graduate on or before March 2015.
3. You are ALS certified eligible for admission to College.

## ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must not have taken any college subject/s previously;
2. Must not be taking any college subject/s at present; and
3. Students enrolled in vocational courses or those not leading to a degree program can apply for the TSU-CAT.

## DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS:

Present Original and submit photocopy only.

1. Form 138 (Report Card)
2. Certificate of Good Moral Character.
3. Authenticated (NSO/PSA) Birth Certificate.
4. 2 pcs. identical 1.77"x1.37"(passport-size) photo with name tag. (DELA CRUZ, JUANA CRUZ)
5. Accomplished TSU-CAT Form (TSU-GUI-SF-16).

## HOW TO QUALIFY FOR AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM:

To qualify in a particular undergraduate degree program, the applicant needs to choose from among the list of courses offered in the University. The applicant needs to indicate the choice of course with its corresponding course code in the TSU College Admission Test Application Form. (E.g. Bachelor of Arts in Communication is coded 1101).

## THE TSU-CAT APPLICATION:

1. Obtain application forms from Counseling, Testing & Career (CTCC) located at TSU Main Campus or download from [www.tsu.edu.ph](http://www.tsu.edu.ph)
2. Fill out the TSU-GUI-SF-16 form in print and bold letters.
4. Requirements should be clipped to the application form.
5. Submit the completed and accomplished application form and requirements to the Main CTCC.
6. Wait for the TEST PERMIT once your application form is submitted

**You are required to come at least 30 minutes before your scheduled time.** Remember to bring the following:

1. Your **TEST PERMIT** (No Test Permit, No Test)
2. Lead **Pencil** No. 2, Quality Eraser
3. 1 valid **ID** for verification
4. Pencil **Sharpener**

**\*NOTE:** The use of any electronic gadget during the test is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. This is a ground for **DISQUALIFICATION** from taking the test.

## WHEN TO CLAIM YOUR TEST RESULT

1. Please refer to your TEST PERMIT for the schedule of releasing of Test Results.
2. Proceed to the Main Counseling, Testing & Career Center and present your TEST to claim your test result.
3. The submission of complete requirements for enrolment is indicated on the Test Result.

## WHAT IF I DO NOT QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE I APPLIED FOR?

If you did not qualify for the course you applied, you have several options. You can try other courses if:

- \* your rating is within their posted cut-off, and
- \* they still have available slots.

However, there is no guarantee of acceptance because each College has its own criteria.
